## Policy Regarding Battery-Powered Mobility Devices

New York Law School ("NYLS") appreciates the efforts of our community members to reduce carbon emissions and traffic congestion by taking alternative means of transportation to campus, including battery-powered bicycles and other battery powered mobility devices, such as scooters, skateboards, hoverboards, and the like. In light of safety concerns, particularly fire hazards, related to the batteries that power such devices, and following the recommendations of the New York City Fire Department and Department of Buildings, on-campus storage of such battery powered mobility devices is prohibited. Accordingly, when a NYLS community member or visitor arrives at campus with a battery-powered mobility device, they will be asked to securely store their devices outside the building.
